1. Inauguration Address from the New President

"A Time When the Significance of the Society is Questioned"

Makoto Okumura, The 18-th President of the ARSC

I have been succeeded Prof. Yoshiaki Ohsawa as the President of the Applied Regional Science Conference (ARSC) for a period of two years from April 2021. Although my insufficient talent, I am determined to work together with the vice president Prof. Takaaki Takahashi, steering committee members, and others for the development of this society.

It has been 34 years since the Society was founded in 1987, and the research environment has changed dramatically since then. Many high-quality texts on basic theories in econometrics, spatial statistics, urban economics, and new urban economics have been published. Electronic journals are now available in online databases, allowing users to search by keywords and citation links, and to use translation tools to translate difficult English texts. At the same time, however, we have entered an era in which it is necessary to grasp global research trends and find your own themes and methods, in which you will demonstrate your originality. I believe that the role of academic societies in these times is "to know what is going on at some distance, by means of of exchange.

The present search method is efficient for getting to know a narrow area in depth, but there is a danger of staying deep in one "well". A talk by a researcher in a neighboring field may not immediately lead to the solution of your own problem, but it may lead to the creation of new ideas over time.

For a long time, our society has been suffering from the imbalance between the stagnant number of members and the cost burden of international journals, etc. However, thanks to the efforts of our seniors, the system of journal publication has been reorganized and some financial room has been created. Taking advantage of this, we have waived the annual membership fee for student members since this year. In addition, due to the COVID-19 pandemical disaster, the Annual Conference of ARSC and the Asian Regional Science Seminar (ASRS) are now decided to be held online. It may dramatically reduce the cost in time and money for participation. Although it is less appealing than sharing the same place and time, and even eating and drinking together, listening to online presentations and chatting back to the presenter with questions and comments can be a good opportunity to make new relationships. Don't be afraid to start interacting with others to find out what's going on a little further away. I strongly hope that this ARSC society will provide such a place.

We are looking forward to receiving ideas and opinions from you, our members, as we move forward in a direction that will lead to the development of the Society. Thank you very much for your support. Finally, I have been pleasantly surprised by the dramatic improvement in machine translation technology provided free of charge by www.DeepL.com to complete this message!
